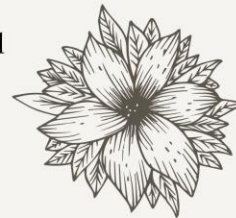
Who are we? We work with the students and staff of NUS to advocate for NUS to be an exemplary model for sustainability and action against climate change.
