Application Form for REAP (Responsible Energy Advocates Programme)

A) Introduction

Drawing upon the energy and passion of youths today on the issue of climate change, the REAP (Responsible Energy Advocates Programme) is aimed at nurturing tertiary students to be energy advocates in raising awareness and in taking action on energy conservation. This is in line with one of the goals under the Sustainability Blueprint of Singapore of boosting resource efficiency through improvements in energy efficiency and optimal use of our resources. Under this programme which is fully funded by YTL PowerSeraya Pte. Limited (hereinafter referred to as YTL PowerSeraya), tertiary students will go through 3 components of the programme as explained below. Throughout the program, students will be mentored by Mr. Kevin Lee, an EcoFriend Award recipient.

1. **Education** – Students will get to attend a workshop centered on ‘Energy Is Life’. Students will learn that energy is connected to virtually every human activity which has an energy footprint and thus climate change impact. They will get to visit a ‘live’ power plant and a chance to learn how a basic solar PV system works.
2. **Community Service** – Using the knowledge gained during the workshop, students will conduct eco-related experiments in their homes to draw connections to environmental and climate change impacts.
3. **Project Work** – Students can either: i) Pursue energy or water conservation projects. Projects may be related to YTL PowerSeraya’s plant operations. Students can leverage on existing school projects (e.g. FYP projects) and relate it to energy/water conservation. Students will present their projects to an independent panel of judges as part of their project work for assessment.

The REAP is a sustainability programme fully sponsored by YTL PowerSeraya, a major power generating company with a vision to be a leading integrated energy company based in Singapore. The REAP is jointly developed by YTL PowerSeraya in partnership with founding partners NEA (National Environment Agency) and South West CDC (Community Development Council).

C) Benefits of the REAP programme to tertiary students

- Practical learning – Students gain knowledge through the workshop and have opportunities to apply the knowledge in real-life through eco experiments (e.g. saving energy, water) in their own homes. They also get to learn how a basic solar PV system works.
- Internship opportunities – Students will be given opportunities to pursue internship stints at YTL PowerSeraya, subject to the company’s selection process for internships.
- Recognition – Upon full completion of the REAP program, students will receive a written testimonial on their contributions to the national effort on energy conservation by YTL PowerSeraya. In addition, they will also receive a certificate of commendation for their role as energy advocates from the National Environment Agency and YTL PowerSeraya.
- Rewards for Delivering Good Outcomes – Top performing students for the project work and community service components (i.e. items A2 & A3 above) get to win prizes. The best performing student stands to win an eco-trip to one of the award winning resorts owned by YTL Corp, the parent company of YTL PowerSeraya.
