### **What is BLUE?**

PM.Haze (People's Movement to Stop Haze) started with just a burning desire to fix an awful problem – the annual haze. From 5 ordinary students and young working adults with no money and influence, PM.Haze has built a movement with 50 volunteers and more than 3,000 supporters on social media. BLUE (Blue sky Leaders with Understanding and Empowerment) is an opportunity to learn about PM.Haze's experience, so you can learn how to run an advocacy project in your campus or other community as part of a nationwide movement to stop haze.

### **How can I participate?**

In March and April, there will be a "try-out" phase for all applicants. Participants will get to attend 2 workshops on **Everyday Leadership** and **Societal Change**. If you're keen to continue and meet the criteria, you'll be selected for the BLUE Leaders' phase from June to October.

The highlight will be a 4 day visit to Malaysia from 21 to 24 July to experience first-hand the complex issues on the ground that lead to fire-prone landscapes. You'll also get to join in the local effort to prevent fires!
