Simply form teams of 4 to 6 and you are ready to go with a pail of water!

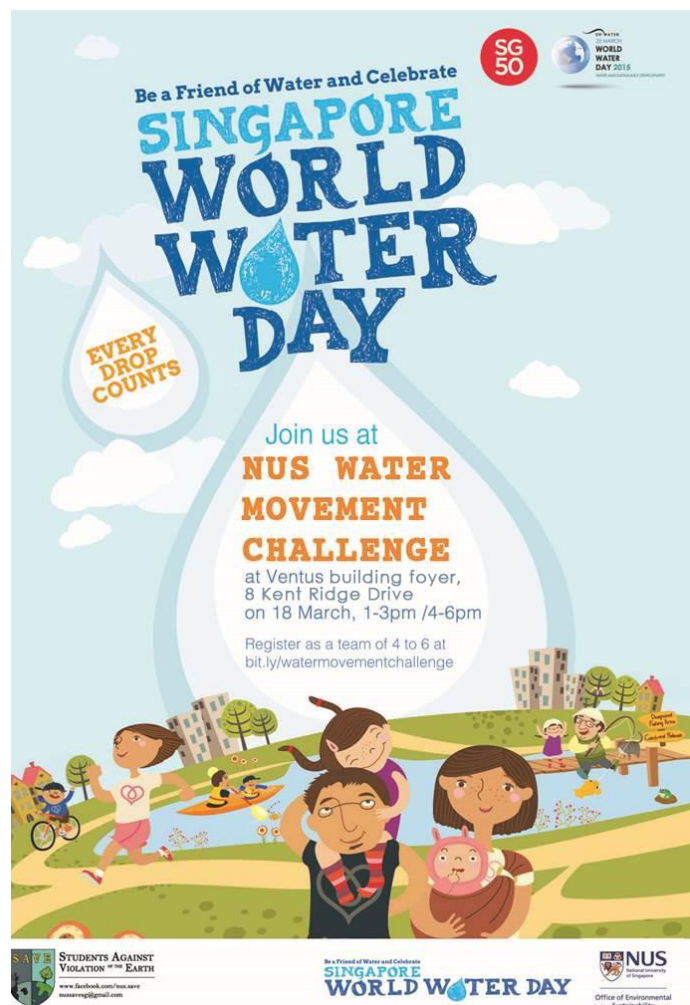
Starting at Ventus, make your way to 4 different stations with the pail of water.
