Safety and Health Policy

In alignment with the University Safety and Health Policy, the University Campus Infrastructure (UCI) is committed to ensuring the safety and health and prevention of injury and ill health to its staff and relevant stakeholders as follows:

1. Safety and Health Culture

UCI is committed to building a safety and health culture in all UCI staff to create a safe and healthy environment for all UCI staff and relevant stakeholders.

2. Legal Compliance

UCI is committed to comply with all applicable safety and health legislation and NUS safety and health requirements and directives.

3. Implementation of a Safety and Health Management Systems

UCI identifies, assesses and controls safety and health hazards associated with UCI activities to prevent injury and ill health to UCI staff and relevant stakeholders. UCI investigates safety and health incidents and non-compliances and implements measures to prevent recurrences. All implementation carried out in a reasonably practicable manner.

4. Regular Monitoring & Review

UCI safety and health management system and performance are monitored and reviewed by the UCI Workplace Safety and Health Committee for effectiveness and continual improvement.

5. Safety and Health Roles and Responsibilities

Every UCI staff has a responsibility to comply with this Policy. UCI management provides the resources to ensure effective implementation of this Policy.



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
