Strategically located within the Kent Ridge campus, The Ridge is now accepting bookings for stays from 22 April 2026 onwards. Designed for overseas academic visitors, research collaborators, executive programme participants, and conference delegates, the accommodation supports their work with a seamless on-campus stay. Offering 185 guest rooms, The Ridge blends campus convenience with modern comfort in an environment where learning, collaboration, and hospitality meet.

Fully developed and operated by NUS, The Ridge features a distinctive π -shaped architectural form symbolising continuous learning and inspired by Kent Ridge's natural topography. Integrated digital hospitality technologies ensure an intelligent and seamless guest experience, while guestroom interiors combine contemporary design with views of surrounding greenery, creating restful spaces that harmonise innovation with nature. This upcoming development will soon take shape on campus, adding a new dimension to academic life and NUS-hosted visitor experience on campus.

JOINING HANDS FOR A GREENER, CLEANER CAMPUS

The NUS community recently showcased its commitment to sustainability by participating in two inspiring initiatives launched by UCI.

On 29 October 2025, staff and students participated in a litter-picking hike across Kent Ridge Campus for SG Clean Day, a Public Hygiene Council initiative. Covering areas from UTown to the University Sports Centre and Science, participants reflected on the often-unseen efforts of cleaning staff while actively contributing to a cleaner, more welcoming campus.

Building on this momentum, a tree planting event was held on 27 November 2025 at the green space next to AS8, in celebration of NUS' 120th Anniversary and Clean and Green Singapore. Staff from UCI, OHR, and other departments, together with students from NUS SAVE, planted 50 young saplings. These included native species and contributed to NUS's goal of planting 100,000 trees by 2030.

Both events exemplify the power of collaboration in fostering a sustainable campus. By rolling up their sleeves and taking part in these hands-on initiatives, the NUS community demonstrates how small actions can collectively create lasting environmental impact. Together, we are shaping a greener, cleaner, and more vibrant campus for all.
